

Paddle Party Rules

- Purchase a numbered paddle for \$3.00 or two paddles for \$5.00. All paddles have a numbered poker chip attached to them with Velcro that corresponds to the number on their paddle. The poker chip is removed and placed in the bucket, which the auctioneer will use to draw numbers from throughout the auction.
- The Magic Paddle this will be the first item up for auction. If you win the Magic Paddle, you no longer have to pay to bid on any of the other items in the auction! To bid with the Magic Paddle, you must hold up the Magic Paddle along with the numbered paddle you won the Magic Paddle with.
- All items will be auctioned for 50 cents (\$0.50). Costs of bids are per paddle, so if you hold up 2 paddles, you pay \$0.50 for each paddle.
- Once you decide to participate in an item up for bid, place your money in the bucket located on your table, and raise your paddle(s). If the winning number paddle was not held up, the auctioneer will draw another number until a winning number is drawn.
- So essentially, you could get a \$50 item for only \$0.50!
- The winning numbered poker chip is placed back in the auctioneer's bucket for the chance at winning again.
- Quarters will be available for purchase at the paddle party
