Sedalia Business and Professional Women's
Club, at the regular meeting held last night at the
Hotel Liberty. Other officers elected were: First
vice-president – Miss Susan Hurlbut. Second
vice-president – Miss Eva Evans. Secretary – Miss
Cecil Tilberry. Treasurer – Miss Christine

Hutchinson. Auditor - Miss Roberta Hurt. Parliamentarian - Mrs. J.C. Connor. Sergeant-at-Arms - Miss Mary O'Bannon. Historian - Miss Rosemary Burrowes. Directors - Mrs. D. W. Tobey and Miss Anna Marie Morseman.
