BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN ELECT

Mrs. N.L. Nelson was elected president of the Sedalia Business and Professional Women's Club, at the regular meeting held last night at the Hotel Liberty. Other officers elected were: First vice-president – Miss Susan Hurlbut. Second vide-president – Miss Eva Evans. Secretary – Miss Cecil Tilberry. Treasurer – Miss Christine Hutchinson. Auditor – Miss Roberta Hurt. Parliamentarian – Mrs. J.C. Connor. Sergeant-at-Arms – Miss Mary O'Bannon. Historian – Miss Rosemary Burrowes. Drectors – Mrs. D. W. Tobey and Miss Anna Marie Morseman.

The Club was to have heard an address by Rev. Raymond C. Lippard, but owing to the fact that there were two other meetings in the ding room of the hotel at the same time, Rev. Lippard's talk was postponed until a later meeting.
