## B.P.W.C. HOLDS FIRST BANQUET IN CLUB ROOMS

#### Plan for Easter Party to be Given Thursday April 21; Adopt "Big Sister" Movement

The members of the Sedalia Business and Professional Women's club had their first dinner in the new club rooms last night. The committee, in charge of Miss Eva Evans, had arranged a delicious plate dinner, with Mrs. Harold Maltby serving Maltby's coffee, which preceded the regular business meeting, presided over by Mrs. N.L. Nelson, the new elected president.

Between the dinner and the business sessions, the members were entertained by a musical program given by Mrs. Joseph Joffe of Yellowstone Park, Miss Irene Sandfort and Herbert Berlin. One new member, Miss Eloise Sanders tuberculosis nurse, was introduced.

Announcement was made of an Easter party to be given in the club room on the night of Thursday, April 21, members who expect to attend to notify Miss Cecil Tolberry, the secretary. They also decided to hold a rummage sale the early part of May, Miss Christine Hutchinson and Mrs. Harold Maltby to be joint chairman.
